# Legal Framework

- Directive 91/271/EEC, concerning urban waste-water treatment
- Directive 2006/7/EC, concerning the management of bathing waters' quality
- Directive 92/43/EEC, on the conservation of natural habitats and of wild fauna and flora
- Directive 2009/147/EC, on the conservation of wild birds
- Directive 78/659/EEC, on the quality of fresh waters needing protection or improvement in order to support fish life
- Directives 79/923/EEC, 91/692/EEC and Council Regulation 1882/2003/EC on the required shellfish waters quality









# **Outcomes**

Total Budget: **6.500.000 €** 









#### Output I:

Water quality improvement projects for drinking or irrigation purposes in islands

- Budget: 3.500.000 € (min. 500.000 €; max. 3.500.000 €)
- Indicative eligible Project Promoters: Water Supply and Sewerage Companies, public authorities, regional and local authorities, research and scientific institutes, management bodies of protected areas









#### **Output II**:

Studies leading to increased knowledge and awareness on the protection and management of water bodies suffering from environmental problems or biodiversity loss

- Budget: 1.500.000 € (min. 200.000 €; max. 1.200.000 €)
- Indicative eligible Project Promoters: Water Supply and Sewerage Companies, public authorities, regional and local authorities, research and scientific institutes, management bodies of protected areas, NGOs









#### **Output III**:

Studies or interventions leading to increased knowledge concerning the integrated marine and islands policy or the protection/management of coastal areas

- Budget: 1.500.000 € (min. 200.000 €; max. 900.000 €)
- Eligible Project Promoters: public authorities, regional and local authorities, research and scientific institutes, management bodies of protected areas, NGOs









#### Improved monitoring of marine waters

#### Output:

Upgrades of existing systems to an integrated marine monitoring programme and coverage of increased area of marine waters

- Pre-defined Project: Implementation of an integrated marine monitoring programme
- Budget: 2.500.000 €
- Project Promoter: Hellenic Center for Marine Research (HCMR)









# Outcome III

Increased awareness of and education in integrated marine and inland water management

#### **Outputs**:

- Environmental educational programmes in primary and secondary education in the field of water resources
- Grants to graduates of higher education in the field of marine and inland water resources management in donor states' institutions or universities
- Total Budget: **1.500.000 €**
- Operated as "Small Grant Schemes"









# **Outcome III**

#### Output I:

Environmental educational programmes in primary and secondary education in the field of water resources

- Budget: 900.000 €
- Grants of 5.000 € to 10.000 €
- 120 educational programmes
- Eligible applicants: public schools (pupils of Primary and Secondary Education and their educators)
- Small Grant Scheme Operator: Ministry of Education









# **Outcome III**

#### Output II:

Grants to graduates of higher education in the field of marine and inland water resources management in donor states' institutions or universities

- Budget: 600.000 €
- Grants of 5.000 € to 30.000 €
- 22 projects of degree/research mobility
- Eligible applicants: graduates of higher education institutions and researchers
- Small Grant Scheme Operator: State Scholarships Foundation (IKY)









# **Bilateral Relations**

#### Activities planned:

- Pre-call information to facilitate stakeholders' timely preparation
- Match-making event to facilitate the search of project partners from the Donor States
- Extra funding during the projects' implementation phase to facilitate networking, exchange and transfer of knowledge etc. between Project Promoters and relevant entities in the Donor States

Budget: **200.000 €** 









# Communication and Publicity

#### **Activities planned:**

- Three (3) conferences: a) a launch-event
  - b) during the implementation phase
  - c) during the completion phase
- Set-up of a website
- Information meetings for Project Promoters and their Partners
- Printed material (brochures/leaflets)
- Publications in national and local newspapers
- Budget: 107.000 €









# Indicative Timetable

Launch of Programme Implementation

End of 2013

- Launch of calls for proposals for outcome I: 1st quarter of 2014
- Signing of Project Contracts for outcome I: 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of 2014
- Launch of predefined project (outcome II): 1<sup>st</sup> semester of 2014
- Small grant schemes (outcome III ) will cover 2 academic years
- Implementation of projects: until the end of the eligible period
