Outcome I

Output I - Call 1

Water quality improvement projects for drinking or irrigation purposes in islands

Budget: 3.500.000 € (min. 500.000 €; max. 3.500.000 €)

The final documents have been sent for signature







Outcome I

Output II- Call 2

Studies leading to increased knowledge and awareness on the protection and management of water bodies suffering from environmental problems or biodiversity loss

Budget: 1.500.000 € (min. 200.000 €; max. 1.200.000 €)

Output III- Call 3

Studies or interventions leading to increased knowledge concerning the integrated marine and islands policy or the protection/management of coastal areas

Budget: 1.500.000 € (min. 200.000 €; max. 900.000 €)

The 2nd draft of the texts have been sent to the FMO for final approval







Outcome II

Improved monitoring of marine waters

Output

Upgrades of existing systems to an integrated marine monitoring programme and coverage of increased area of marine waters

Pre-defined Project: Implementation of an integrated marine monitoring programme
