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# Steps of organizing the webinar 1: Preparation of the agenda

The aim of the Webinar on 28/9/2020, organized by the Program Operator CRES was:

# Steps of organizing the webinar 3: Drafting the Registration Form


The **REGISTRATION FORM** included the following information:

- Name of the organization
- Surname
- First Name
- Contact email address
- Contact Phone number

A total of **63 people registered** to participate in the Webinar from the Public and Private sector. Specifically:

- **38 people registered from the Public Sector**, of which 9 were from Municipalities and 11 from Universities,
- 25 people registered from the Private sector,
- 35 people were from Athens,
- 24 people were from Province and
- 4 people were from abroad

The number of the Registration Forms is an Indicator for the successful implementation of the communication activity.





# Steps of organizing the webinar 4: Purchase of the Microsoft Teams application

Programme Operator purchased 2 "**Microsoft 365 for Business**" licenses for the efficient and reliable holding of the Webinar. According to the PO Communication Plan, <u>online meetings is part of the</u> internal (among the Project Partners) and external (among Stakeholders, the general public, etc.) <u>communication of the Program</u>.

Due to the pandemic, web conferencing software such as MS Teams offers a <u>digital communication interface</u> for the competent bodies involved in the Program.

Advantages of the online meetings:

- Easy access for Stakeholders,
- Interaction between all the participants,
- Share content (presentations, videos etc.)
- Chat feature,
- Auto-translation feature,
- Allows dialogue, as well as the possibility of written communication etc.






#### Steps of organizing the webinar 5: Publication of the Invitation for the Webinar


